

Notes from Shannon

What a wonderful Fall we are having! The children and staff have been enjoying the late September warmth, as we enjoy all of the new elements on our play yards and continue to explore our community parks, soaking up as much time in nature as possible before we need to get back into winter jackets, snow pants, mittens and boots!

A big thank you goes out to all of our families who came out to have a Family Photo Session in September! Thanks to your participation, we were able to raise \$1170.00 for Horizons programs.

Our currently running fundraiser is the Grey Cup Raffle Tickets!

As a Blue Bomber season ticket holder, I have simply taken them to the games, and been able to sell several packs of 10, however you do not need to be a football fan to purchase, or to sell these tickets, as it is first and foremost, a raffle!

Tickets are \$5 each. The small stub at the end is where the purchaser fills in their contact information. The larger part, stays with the purchaser and the money and small stub are returned to the centre.

Prizes this year are \$100 for the correct score at the end of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd quarters, or \$50 for the correct score in reverse. (Ie. If the correct score is 14 for the West, and 3 for the East, and that is what your ticket reads, you would win \$100. If your ticket reads 3 for the West and 14 for the East, you would win \$50!)

At the end of the game, any tickets with the correct final score win \$200, and the correct score in reverse will win \$100. Who doesn't like to win money? Please consider picking up a set of 10 tickets or more and try your luck in selling them to friends, family and colleagues in support of our programs!

How are you all enjoying Hot Lunch happening every week? We are using this as a way to determine if a full-time hot lunch program would be feasible for our centres, and will be sending out a survey by mid November via the Parent App, to determine family's interest. A hot lunch program would be much like the snack program. If you sign up, then you will be billed for the full billing period, each day, and lunch would be provided each day for your child, so it would not be a situation where you pick and choose days to register. As one of our pillars in our Strategic Plan, we want to ensure that we are fully investigating feasibility before proceeding!

We will also be sending out a survey in January 2026 to get your feedback on the new PARENT APP, both positive and negative, to determine if the app is meeting the needs of our parents as well as our staff, so please ensure that you are signed up for the app, and checking for these surveys and other important messages regularly! We know it is another app to monitor, but want to ensure that we are moving with technology, and meeting our parents needs effectively.

We would like to take this time to welcome some new faces at our sites! Welcome to Sarita, Samy and Pavreet, who are joining us in the Owls and Bisons rooms at Access, and to Marykate (2nd year student, Red River Polytech) Nerissa and Heather in the Hatchlings room at Hampton! We hope that you are feeling a part of this warm and wonderful Horizons community, and thank you for all that you do!

We are looking into new projects to tackle in 2026 at all three sites, now that the grant writing season is upon us, and hope to accomplish more items on our wish list in the year ahead!
